

## Kids Voting in New Hampshire on Election Day

CONCORD, NH: Students in eleven cities and towns across New Hampshire will have the opportunity to vote with their families on Election Day. Volunteers will be collecting Kids Voting New Hampshire ballots for statewide offices all day for students in grades K-12. Kids Voting NH is a statewide community-based program that combines civic education activities in the classroom with an authentic voting experience on Election Day.
