

This poll was conducted by Mason-Dixon Polling & Research, Inc. of Washington, D.C. from June 21st through 24th. A total of 800 registered Nevada voters were interviewed statewide by telephone. All stated they were likely to participate in the 2008 presidential selection process.

Those interviewed were selected randomly from a voter registration list of voters who have participated in past caucuses or have voted in one of three recent statewide primary elections.

The margin for error, according to standards customarily used by statisticians, is no more than plus or minus 3.5% percentage points. This means that there is a 95 percent probability that the "true" figure would fall within that range if the entire population were sampled. 400 Democrats and 400 Republicans were interviewed. The margins for error for those samples is no more than plus or minus 4.9% percentage points

Estimated response rate is 65%.

Each number is dialed 8 times before being dropped.
